The school will:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 pandemic
- Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can
- Encourage all pupils to adhere to social distancing as reasonably as possible
- Greet the children every morning with a smile (while still keeping the 2 metre distance rule)
- Take the time to explain the school day and the rules we need to follow at this time
- Provide the children with individual resources that they will need when at school such as pens and pencils
- Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and consequences for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy and COVID-19 Behaviour Addendum
- Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19
- Inform parents/carers if staff or pupils in your child's 'bubble' test positive for COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate
- Communicate between home and school through newsletters, text, email and the website

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school; we will selfisolate for 14 days as a family. I will get them tested and I will let the school know the results, as soon as possible via telephone
- If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will
 collect my child from school immediately. I will get them
 tested and I will let the school know the result as soon as
 possible via telephone
- On my commute, and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child
- When dropping off, my child will remove any disposable face mask that they are wearing, which I will take away with me
- My child will not bring any items into school with them or take items home from school
- I will not be allowed into the school without a prearranged appointment. Make appointments via telephone or email
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this time
- I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home
- I will inform the school of any changes to parents/carer and emergency contacts details

I will:

- Follow the school values of Respect, Responsibility, Resilience and Co-operation at all times
- Follow the Bubble rules that keep me safe
- Not mix with children in another Bubble
- Only enter and exit the school building as directed by my teacher
- Tell an adult if I feel unwell
- Wash my hands as soon as I go into school and regularly throughout the day, using soap and water for 20 seconds
- Follow the catch it-bin it-kill it rules, coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue
- Not bring things into school from home or take things home from school
- Only use the equipment on my desk
- Keep my packed lunch and water bottle on my desk
