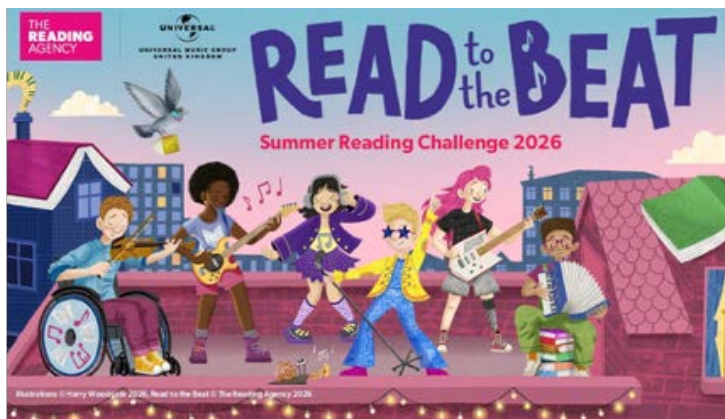
Cineworld – Secondary School Event
