- **Pause:** Before sharing news with other parents/carers, ask yourself: *Is this definitely true? Is sharing this helpful? Could this cause someone distress?*
- **Model Mindful Communication:** Our children look to us to see how we handle conflict and information. By staying calm and factual, we teach them how to navigate the world responsibly.

Our goal is to keep our school a safe, happy, and focused place for your children to learn. Thank you for your continued support in keeping our community spirit positive.
