**Year 6 end of year arrangements**

As we approach the end of the year, we have planned a series of activities for our Year 6 pupils to ensure that we give them a good send off and prepare them for secondary school.

***Tolmers Residential Update***

Given the cancellation of the Tolmers trip, we have worked quickly to organise alternative activities. We are still awaiting refunds from Tolmers and we will return these to you as soon as we get them.

***Junior Citizenship Scheme Trip - Monday 13 June***

Activities: Pupils will take part in a range of activities as part of the Junior Citizenship Scheme. There will be sessions led by the Metropolitan Police and TfL relating to good citizenship and how to travel safely to secondary school.
