## Welcome back

It's good to see everyone back after the long summer break. A special welcome to the pupils and parents of year 3 children and to those families who have joined the school this term. We look forward to getting to know you and working with you to ensure we deliver the very best for your child.

## Uniform

We are very pleased to see our pupils looking smart in their new navy blue sweatshirts. Could I please take this opportunity to remind you that the uniform is a white polo shirt with a grey skirt or trousers, not black, and also that pupils should wear plain black shoes or plain black trainers. Thank you.

## Year 6 - 11-13 September

The majority of our Year 6 pupils will be visiting Tolmers Scout Camp. They should arrive at school on **Wednesday** 11 September at 8:30am with their full kit. They should be collected from school at 2:30pm on Friday 13 September.

Pupils who are not attending Tolmers should still arrive at school at the normal time and will finish at 3:15pm. A variety of activities have been arranged which include outdoor art sessions and circus skills provided by a qualified instructor. Children not attending Tolmers will be able to wear their own clothes to school for the 3 days.

## Collection at home time

To keep your child safe at home time can we please ask that when collecting your child at 3:15pm, you wait behind the white line for your child to be dismissed by the class teacher. Also, we are only able to release children to people who are on the 'pick up' list. Please notify your child's teacher, in writing, of anybody else you wish to add to the list. Thank you.

## Photographer - 9 September 2019

A professional photographer will visit school on Monday to take photographs of pupils so we can have up-to-date images of our children learning throughout the day. Working with the new School Parliament, we will select images to be printed onto canvases which will be displayed across the school and some of them will be published on our website. Please ensure your child wears full school uniform. The photos will be used on our website as well as on images and artwork displayed around the school and also in our school brochure.

## MP visit to school

Today, Friday 6 September, we were visited by Bambos Charalambous MP, a British politician. He was elected as the Labour Party MP for Enfield Southgate in 2017. He came to speak to all the pupils in our assembly and explained how he was elected as MP. Our School Parliament elections will take place soon so it was enlightening to hear about the process of election in the Houses of Parliament.

## Autumn term school clubs

If your child is allocated a place on a school club, you will be informed of the allocations by Friday 13 September. Items for payment will appear on ParentPay. Payments can also be made using the bar coded letter which will be issued on Friday 13 September. Payment will be due by Wednesday 18 September.

## Student update form

Next week your child will bring home a 'Student Update' form. This form contains information which the school holds on your child. Please check this form very carefully, update as necessary, and return to your child's teacher by Friday 13 September (please return even if you do not make any changes).

In line with 'Keeping Children Safe in Education' guidance, it is vital that we have **at least two contact phone numbers** for your child. Please also ensure you check the form and update **who is allowed to collect** your child from school as we are unable to release pupils to persons who are not listed. Thank you.
